Re: Proposed Session Dates for the 2020-2021 Academic Year

REPORT CLASSIFICATION

This is a major policy matter that will be considered by the Executive Committee for endorsing and forwarding to Faculty Council for vote as a regular motion (requiring a simple majority of members present and voting to carry).

BACKGROUND

The Undergraduate Curriculum Committee is composed of representatives from each undergraduate program; the Vice-Dean, Undergraduate Studies; the Vice-Dean, First Year; the Associate Dean, Cross-Disciplinary Programs; the Director, First Year Curriculum; the Registrar's Office; undergraduate students; the Faculty's Teaching and Learning Specialist; the Faculty's Scheduling Officer; and representatives from IBBME, UTIAS, the Engineering Communication Program, and the Engineering and Computer Science Library. The Committee meets regularly, and reviews changes to the curriculum.

The Undergraduate Curriculum Committee is responsible for determining session dates for each academic year through consultation with the Colleges and Residences, as well as with the University holiday schedule. This year, in spite of the late Labour Day, the central administration has opted to start classes for essentially all faculties on Thursday September 10, 2020. This late start to the academic year will result in an unusually short fall examination period. Examinations will be scheduled on evenings, Saturdays, and Sundays.
