Re: Proposed Session Dates for the 2021-2022 Academic Year

REPORT CLASSIFICATION

This is a major policy matter that will be considered by the Executive Committee for endorsing and forwarding to Faculty Council for vote as a regular motion (requiring a simple majority of members present and voting to carry).

BACKGROUND

The Undergraduate Curriculum Committee is comprised of faculty representatives from undergraduate programs; undergraduate student representatives; the Vice-Dean, Undergraduate Studies; The First Year Office; the Associate Dean, Cross-Disciplinary Programs; and the Registrar. The Committee meets regularly to review and approve proposed changes to the undergraduate curriculum.

The Undergraduate Curriculum Committee is responsible for determining session dates for each academic year through consultation with the Colleges and Residences, as well as with the University holiday schedule.
